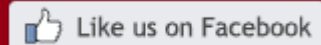

E-MAGAZINES AT YOUR LIBRARY!

South San Francisco Public Library has recently added Zinio, a service that lets library users borrow electronic magazines to be read on a computer or tablet device. There are plenty of useful reasons to try Zinio. With 159 different magazines to offer, access to Zinio includes more magazines than each individual library subscribes to in print, as well as access to many more back-issues. The Zinio collection includes top business titles such as The Economist, Entrepreneur Magazine and Fast Company.

Additional Zinio features include the ability to check-out as many magazines as you want at any time, and for as long as you want, and also the option to easily print any page of a

magazine. Zinio allows you to view and read the latest magazine issues at home, or on the go.

To sign-up for Zinio, visit ssf.net/library. The service is free; you just need a South San Francisco Public Library card. Tablet and smartphone users can install the Zinio for Libraries app and download issues to read while offline, ideal for air travel. For assistance installing Zinio, contact or visit the library.
