#### **Listening to Improve Your Personal and Professional Relationships** By Steve Disselhorst, MBA, CPCC, PCC

Listening is a fundamental skill that strengthens relationships and fosters meaningful connections. Active listening goes beyond merely hearing words—it involves actively seeking to understand what's behind the words, essentially the other person's intent and emotions. Active listening requires presence, curiosity, and an open mind, allowing for deeper connection and trust.

Research indicates that inadequate listening skills impact over 70% of employees, resulting in misunderstandings, errors, missed opportunities, conflicts, and damaged relationships. Conversely, when employees feel heard, they are 4.6 times more likely to feel empowered and perform at their best. The same holds true for personal relationships—being truly listened to strengthens bonds and diminishes misunderstandings.

There are two levels of listening: **ME listening** and **YOU listening**. ME listening occurs when you interpret what someone is saying through your experiences, relating everything to yourself. While this can create connections, it often shifts the focus away from the speaker.

In contrast, YOU listening means fully concentrating on the other person, setting aside personal biases and experiences to understand their perspective deeply. YOU listening is characterized by curiosity, openness, non-judgment, attentiveness, and the practice of asking open-ended questions. To enhance your active listening skills, avoid closed-ended questions and **'Why'** questions, and instead ask **'What?'** or **'How?'** questions that encourage openness and depth. YOU listening fosters trust and connection, strengthening your relationships.

By improving how we listen, we can create stronger, more fulfilling relationships in all areas of life.
