

August is National Immunization Awareness Month

Vaccines are a lifesaving breakthrough of modern medicine. Because of vaccination efforts, smallpox was eradicated from the United States in 1949. Other serious diseases like polio are also nearing elimination. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has estimated that vaccinations will <u>prevent</u> more than **21 million** hospitalizations and **732,000** deaths among children born in the last 20 years. We've also seen high vaccination rates in the U.S. for decades.

Vaccines have become a hot-button topic because misinformation has wrongly associated vaccines with conditions like autism, disabilities, or other medical concerns. Research overwhelmingly shows that vaccine safety is very high, while providing protection against serious illness. Misleading information shared by online skeptics can cause significant harm to people who opt out of getting their vaccines.

It's important to understand how vaccines work. They are used to help prevent serious diseases or illnesses from happening or spreading. The vaccine itself is a safe substance that contains a small amount of a weakened or dead virus or bacteria.

Some common vaccines include chickenpox, COVID-19, flu (influenza), hepatitis (A & B), human papillomavirus (HPV), measles, mumps and rubella, polio, shingles, tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis (whooping cough).

Immunization is the process of becoming protected — or immune — to a disease or illness. When your body is exposed to a vaccine, your immune system will produce antibodies that protect you against that disease. Your body will then be able to recognize and fight the disease if you're ever exposed to it.

Vaccines help prevent serious illness, and it's important to stay up to date on all vaccines. Kaiser Permanente offers walk-in seasonal vaccine clinics for our members beginning in September. Learn more about vaccines at kp.org.
