Tell us about your history in SSF

Mayra Amador has called South San Francisco home since birth. She was
raised by her loving parents, Maria and Vicente Gonzalez, along with her older
brother and 5 younger sisters. She attended Martin Elementary School,
Parkway Heights Middle School, and South San Francisco High School. She

has memories of playing in SSF parks (Orange Park & Paradise Valley), visiting the Grand Avenue library (as she has always had a great love of books), regularly taking sports and arts & crafts classes through Park & Rec and playing soccer, volleyball, and running on the track team for SSFHS.

 Oscar joined the SSF family when he and Mayra got married in August of 2017 and she brought him to live in her hometown.

Tell us about Mayra's background as a scholarship recipient. The years? Her educational history? Her major in school, etc.

- Mayra graduated from South San Francisco High School in 2011. That was the
  year that she received the Chamber of Commerce scholarship which
  supported her education at Santa Clara University. She earned her Bachelor of
  Science in Public Health and Psychology.
- Mayra went on to complete a professional certificate program offered through the Stanford Prevention Research Center which focused on community health and chronic disease prevention.
- Most recently (just 2 weeks ago on May 15th), Mayra graduated from UC Berkeley with her Master's in Public Health with a concentration in epidemiology and biostatistics. She looks forward to using her skills to serve our most disadvantaged and vulnerable communities in the Bay Area and to move the needle toward health equity.

Tell us about your business and why you support the Chamber


- At the age of 16, Oscar Amador dropped out of high school and became the sole provider for his family including his mom and 3 siblings. It was challenging to find a job for himself and his mother, so they decided to create and share business cards to promote their combined handyman and house cleaning services. He worked as a handyman and landscaper for many years while maintaining a full-time job in construction. In 2018, Oscar obtained his General Contractor license and with the support of his wife, Mayra, officially started Amador General Construction, Inc. This business provides construction services all over the Bay Area from the foundation to the finished product.
- Although his high school career ended during his sophomore year, Oscar dreamed of one day earning his GED to finish what he had started. In 2021, he did just that! He feels that it is never too late to pursue one's goals and strongly believes in lifelong learning.
- Oscar and Mayra are excited to be members of the Chamber and look forward to developing partnerships with fellow members and participating in the high school scholarship program.

Tell us about your philosophy of PAYING IT FORWARD so others can benefit.

- Mayra feels so incredibly grateful to all who supported her on her educational journey. She appreciates her parents for instilling in her the importance of education, lifelong learning, and of giving back to our community.
- Oscar has always wanted to give back to others. Growing up there were many people who helped him, his mother, and siblings get through tough times.




