Dear SSF Chamber of Commerce member:

South San Francisco Unified School District (SSFUSD) is seeking volunteers to serve on the Measure T citizens' bond oversight committee (CBOC).

In accordance with Education Code 15266, CBOC members will review bond expenditures and report to the public whether the funds have been spent on school construction as specified in the Measure T ballot measure approved by voters during the November 2022 midterm elections.

The committee will meet approximately 4-6 times a year and must consist of a minimum of seven (7) individuals from the following groups:

- Active member of a business organization or member of the business community located within the boundaries of SSFUSD;
- Active member of a senior citizens' organization;
- Active member of a bona fide taxpayer organization;
- · Parent/guardian of an SSFUSD student; and
- · Parent/guardian of an SSFUSD student who is also active in a parent-teacher organization.

Committee members will serve at least one two-year term. No employee, official, vendor, contractor, or consultant of SSFUSD shall be appointed to the CBOC.

Individuals interested in serving on the CBOC should download and complete a <u>CBOC application form</u>, which can be obtained from the district website or from SSFUSD's business services department located at 398 B Street, South San Francisco, CA 94080.
