I was born and raised in South San Francisco, along with two brothers and three sisters. Both of our parents were immigrants from Mexico. My family worked at three different companies: Swift Meat Company, Berkey Photo (which is now the Conference Center), and Armour Meat Company. None of these companies exist now, their spaces have been occupied by a wave of biotech companies that have turned South San Francisco from its origins as The Industrial City, into the Biotech Capital of the World.



I remember as a kid walking with my friends down Grand Avenue, stopping by JC Penney and then picking up a pastry at Galli's Sanitary Bakery. My parents bought their first home in 1951 for the staggering price of eight thousand dollars. Back then, there were a lot of empty lots along Grand and Spruce Avenues. These lots have been filled with five stories buildings offering million dollars condominiums.

The nature of the landscape has changed dramatically, JC Penney has long been gone. Sanitary Bakery ended three-generations of ownership and made way for a new generation of entrepreneurs. Traditional European cuisine has given way to the flavors of Asia and the Middle East. Yet, each one of these brings their own contribution to the growth and development of this magical City of ours.

Through the changes and innovations that South City has gone through, The Chamber of Commerce has served as an important entity to welcome new businesses and to strengthened established partnerships. California Reinstates COVID-19 Supplemental Paid Sick Leave (SPSL) for 2022 By: Paul V. Simpson, Esq. and Sean R. Broderick, Esq.

As a result of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, and specifically in response to the Omicron variant, on February 9, 2022, Governor Newsom signed Senate Bill 114, the COVID-19 Supplemental Paid Sick Leave law, which requires employers with 26 or more employees to provide up to 80 hours of Supplemental Paid Sick Leave ("SPSL") for qualifying COVID-19 related reasons. Specifically, the 2022 SPSL law provides covered employees with up to 40 SPSL hours for COVID-related isolation and quarantine, receiving vaccines, and caring for a child whose school or place of care is closed, and up to an additional 40 SPSL hours available only when an employee, or family member for whom the employee provides care, tests positive for COVID-19. This 2022 COVID-19 SPSL is in addition to regular paid sick leave.

The new law became effective Saturday February 19, 2022, and is retroactive to January 1, 2022, and is set to expire on September 30, 2022. Although the 2022 SPSL law is similar to the 2021 SPSL (Senate Bill 95) that expired on September 30, 2021,

there are some significant differences explained in the following article, which can reviewed **here**.
