#### **Director Kathy Hoffman with California Water Service**

California Water Service supports Governor Newsom's recent call for Californians to conserve water during the drought, and as South San Francisco's water provider, we are here to help the community save water every day.

Our South San Francisco customers did an excellent job reducing water use during the last drought, and we appreciate your ongoing efforts to protect this most precious resource. To support our residential and business customers' conservation goals, we offer a number of new and existing programs, including:



- · Rebates on high-efficiency appliances and devices, with certain rebates recently doubled
- · A Smart Landscape Tune-Up Program that includes an irrigation system evaluation along with installation of efficient devices and repair of most irrigation leaks at no cost to the customer
- Free residential Conservation Kits that include a garden hose nozzle with shutoff valve, high-efficiency showerheads, faucet aerators, leak detector tablets, and more
- · Lawn-to-garden rebate
- · Spray-to-drip rebate
- · A customized incentive program for large-use commercial customers
- Educational resources

We encourage South San Francisco residents and businesses to keep using water wisely, and to remember that there are some prohibited uses of water that remain in effect. We are currently in Stage 1 of our Water Shortage Contingency Plan, also called Schedule 14.1. Stage 1 provides for the ability to assess penalties for violating the prohibited uses of water; however, we always prefer to work with our customers instead. The more common water-wasting activities include:

- · Using water on outdoor landscaping that causes runoff onto adjacent properties or paved areas
- · Washing vehicles with a hose that doesn't have a shutoff nozzle or similar device
- · Not repairing leaks within five days of notification
- · Irrigating outdoors between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m.
- · Using water in a fountain or other decorative water feature that doesn't use a recirculating system

The full list of prohibited uses of water can be found at **calwater.com/conservation**, where you can also find details about our conservation programs and Water Shortage Contingency Plan.

While South San Francisco residents and businesses step up your efforts, we are taking comprehensive action to tackle climate change and ensure long-term water supply reliability, too. Some of these preparations include:

- · Replacing, repairing, and upgrading infrastructure to minimize water loss
- · Identifying and repairing leaks through our Water Loss Auditing and Control Program
- Developing a 30-year Water Supply and Facilities Master Plan for South San Francisco, which enables us to identify and address any potential long-term gaps in supplies
- · Updating our local Conservation Master Plan to help determine programs that would most benefit South San Francisco-area customers and reduce water use

California is no stranger to droughts, and together, we will weather this drought and ensure South San Francisco customers and firefighters continue to have a reliable supply of safe, clean water for their everyday and emergency needs, both now and for decades to come.


