South San Francisco Police Chief Jeff Azzopardi to Retire at the End of the Year

SOUTH SAN FRANCISCO, **Calif.**, September 1, 2021 – After nearly 30 years of service to the residents of South San Francisco, Police Chief Jeff Azzopardi is ready to hang up his hat.

"This is bittersweet for me. This community and my colleagues are my family and it's hard to say goodbye, but I'm also looking forward to a new chapter in my life and spending more time with my family," said Police Chief Jeff Azzopardi.

"Chief Azzopardi will be sorely missed at the City. The respect he has from his department and his colleagues within the City is something to be admired. We have been lucky to have him part of the police department for as long

as we have," said South San Francisco Mayor Mark Addiego.

Chief Azzopardi was appointed South San Francisco Police Chief in September, 2014. He started his law enforcement career with the South San Francisco Police Department in 1993. Over the course of his career, Azzopardi rose through the departmental ranks serving as Corporal, Sergeant, Lieutenant, and ultimately Captain in 2009. As a Captain, Azzopardi led both the Operations Division as well as the Services Division. "Azzopardi's experience, along with his collaborative leadership, provides the ideal foundation for partnerships with the community to make sure that South San Francisco remains one of the safest cities in the bay area," adds Mayor Addiego.
