RISK LEVEL

Allowed Indoors

- ▶ Family Entertainment Centers at 50% capacity
- ▶ Amusement Parks at 25% indoors, 35% outdoors
- ▶ Movie Theaters at 50% capacity
- ▶ Mall Food Courts at 50% capacity
- ▶ Restaurants at 50% capacity
- ▶ Bars at 25% capacity
- ▶ Wineries, Breweries and Distilleries at 50% capacity
- ▶ Places of Worship at 50% capacity
- ▶ Gyms and Fitness Centers at 50% capacity plus saunas & steam rooms
- ▶ Sleepaway Camps open June 1, 2021, with modifications

Allowed Outdoors

- ▶ Live Events at 67% capacity with modifications. In-state visitors only.



Counties can move to a less restrictive level as COVID transmission goes down and testing goes up.

Stay diligent & follow safety guidelines: keep your distance, wear your mask, self quarantine if you've been exposed & get tested.

RESTAURANT REVITALIZATION FUND ELIGIBILITY

- ✔ Started business, (fully open, full operations) prior to or on January 1, 2019.
- ✔ Began operations on or between January 1, 2020 and March 10, 2021
- ✔ Started business after January 2019
- ✔ Not yet opened as of March 11, 2021, but have incurred eligible expenses

RESTAURANT REVITALIZATION FUND GUIDE

Who is eligible to Apply:

- Restaurants
- Food stands, food trucks, food carts
- Caterers
- Bars, saloons, lounges, taverns
- Snack and nonalcoholic beverage bars
- Bakeries*
- Brewpubs, tasting rooms, taprooms, breweries and/or microbreweries*
- Wineries and distilleries*
- Inns*
- Licensed facilities or premises of a beverage alcohol producer where the public may taste, sample, or purchase products



*onsite sales of food and beverage to the public comprise at least 33% of gross receipts.

Step 1 - Register the business

<https://restaurants.sba.gov/application-portal>.

Step 2 - Compile digital documents ready to upload

Acceptable documentation of gross receipts and, if applicable, eligible expenses:

- Business tax returns (IRS Form 1120 or IRS 1120-S)
- IRS Forms 1040 Schedule C; IRS Forms 1040 Schedule F
- For a partnership: partnership's IRS Form 1065 (including K-1s)
- 3 months Bank statements: (Jan-April)
- Externally or internally prepared Income Statements or Profit and Loss Statements
- Point of Sale report(s), including IRS Form 1099-K.
- IRS form 4506T (one-page document which allows SBA to ask IRS for copy of Tax Returns to confirm what was submitted is true) <https://www.irs.gov/pub/irs-pdf/f4506.pdf>

Step 3 - Review Sample RRF Application

Same Application

Have ownership information for everyone with 20% or more interest in the business including Social Security Number, ownership percentage, home address.
