The State of California is accepting applications for a major new grant program. The \$500 million California Small Business Relief Grant will provide \$5,000, \$15,000 or \$25,000 grants to eligible small businesses that have been affected by COVID-19.

Applications for Round 1 opened on Wednesday, December 30th, 2020 and will close at the end of day on <u>new</u> closing date January 13th, 2021 at 11:59 pm.


