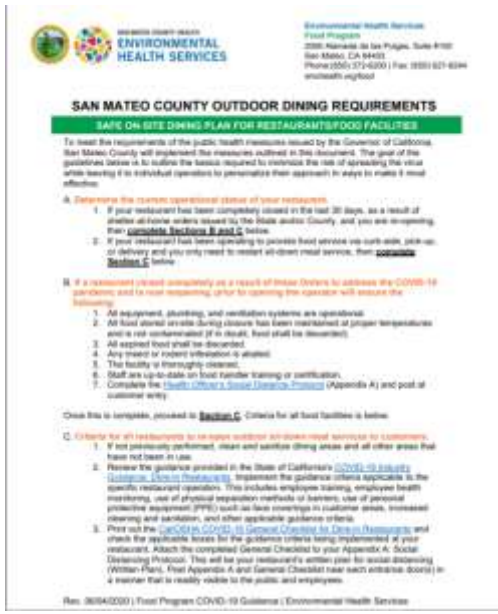

Dining Guidelines

To ensure we have a safe reopening, please follow all health and safety guidelines. These include:

- Maximum of 6 people per table, all from the same family/social group
- All tables are separated by at least 6 feet
- Retail must limit capacity to 50% or ensure all customers maintain 6 feet social distancing (whichever is lower)
