The South San Francisco Education Foundation, (EIN:85-2930060), will support and enhancement of education and educational programs within the South San Francisco Unified School District boundaries providing funding support for both the school district and individual school programs and offering and managing scholarship programs for “qualified students” seeking university, college, or vocational advancement. Determinations as to which students shall be “qualified” for any such scholarship program are to be made in the discretion of the board of directors and officers of the South San Francisco Education Foundation.

Because of the generosity of the local business sponsors, deserving high school students in our community have the opportunity to apply for a scholarship to support their higher learning. Your pledge of \$1,000.00 or more, provides hope and encourages local students to return to their roots and work where they once grew up. The scholarships will be awarded to high school seniors that are residents of South San Francisco and will be seeking university, college, or vocational advancement.
